RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2333) to authorize appropriations for the Department of State, the United States Information Agency, and related agencies, to authorize appropriations for foreign assistance programs, and for other purposes, and the bill (H.R. 2404) to authorize appropriations for foreign assistance programs, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of

1 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
2 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
3 ation of the bill (H.R. 2333) to authorize appropriations
4 for the Department of State, the United States Informa-
5 tion Agency, and related agencies, to authorize appropria-
6 tions for foreign assistance programs, and for other pur-
7 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
8 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
9 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
10 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
11 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
12 Committee on Foreign Affairs. After general debate the
13 Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No fur-
14 ther consideration of the bill shall be in order except pur-
15 suant to a subsequent order of the House.

16 SEC. 2. At any time after the adoption of this resolu-
17 tion the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of rule
18 XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
19 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
20 ation of the bill (H.R. 2404) to authorize appropriations
21 for foreign assistance programs, and for other purposes.
22 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All
23 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
24 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
25 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the

1 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
2 on Foreign Affairs. After general debate the Committee
3 of the Whole shall rise without motion. No further consid-
4 eration of the bill shall be in order except pursuant to a
5 subsequent order of the House.
