1 *Resolved*, That all points of order against consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2520) making appropriations for
3 the Department of the Interior and related agencies for
4 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other
5 purposes, are waived. During consideration of the bill, all
6 points of order against the following provisions in the bill

1 for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are
2 waived: beginning on page 4, line 22, through page 5, line
3 13; beginning on page 14, line 1, through “construction”
4 on line 11; beginning on page 54, line 1, through line 4;
5 beginning on page 58, line 14, through line 22; beginning
6 on page 78, line 8, through page 80, line 10; beginning
7 on page 85, line 15, through page 86, line 15; beginning
8 on page 86, line 20, through page 87, line 3; and begin-
9 ning on page 89, line 18, through line 21. Where points
10 of order are waived against only part of a paragraph, a
11 point of order against matter in the balance of the para-
12 graph may be applied only within the balance of the para-
13 graph and not against the entire paragraph.
