RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2010) to amend the National and Community Service Act of 1990 to establish a Corporation for National Service, enhance opportunities for national service, and provide national service educational awards to persons participating in such service, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2010) to amend the National and
3 Community Service Act of 1990 to establish a Corporation
4 for National Service, enhance opportunities for national
5 service, and provide national service educational awards
6 to persons participating in such service, and for other pur-
7 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
8 Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure
9 to comply with section 302(f) of the Congressional Budget
10 Act of 1974 are waived. General debate shall be confined
11 to the bill and shall not exceed three hours equally divided
12 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
13 member of the Committee on Education and Labor. After
14 general debate the Committee of the Whole shall rise with-
15 out motion. No further consideration of the bill shall be
16 in order except pursuant to a subsequent order of the
17 House.
