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## RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 2010) to amend the National and Community Service Act of 1990 to establish a Corporation for National Service, enhance opportunities for national service, and provide national service educational awards to persons participating in such service, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further  
2 consideration of the bill (H.R. 2010) to amend the Na-  
3 tional and Community Service Act of 1990 to establish  
4 a Corporation for National Service, enhance opportunities  
5 for national service, and provide national service edu-  
6 cational awards to persons participating in such service,  
7 and for other purposes. No further general debate shall  
8 be in order. The bill shall be considered for amendment  
9 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider  
10 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under  
11 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
12 stitute recommended by the Committee on Education and  
13 Labor now printed in the bill. The committee amendment  
14 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.  
15 Points of order against the committee amendment in the  
16 nature of a substitute for failure to comply with section  
17 302(f) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 or clause  
18 5(a) of rule XXI are waived. Other than pro forma amend-  
19 ments for the purpose of debate, no amendment to the  
20 committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall  
21 be in order unless printed in the portion of the Congres-  
22 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of  
23 rule XXIII prior to Tuesday, July 20, 1993. The amend-  
24 ments en bloc caused to be printed by Representative Ford  
25 of Michigan shall be considered as read and shall not be

1 subject to a demand for division of the question in the  
2 House or in the Committee of the Whole. At the conclu-  
3 sion of consideration of the bill for amendment the Com-  
4 mittee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
5 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may  
6 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
7 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
8 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.  
9 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
10 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without  
11 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
12 or without instructions.
