RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that signatures on discharge petitions be made public immediately.

1 *Resolved*, That the first undesignated paragraph of
2 clause 3 of rule XXVII of the Rules of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives is amended by inserting after the third sen-
4 tence the following new sentence: “A current list of the
5 names of all Members signing each such motion shall be
6 made available by the Clerk for public inspection during
7 normal working hours.”.
