Mr. WHEAT, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2667) making emergency supplemental appropriations for relief from the major, widespread flooding in the Midwest for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2667) making emergency supple-

1 mental appropriations for relief from the major, wide-
2 spread flooding in the Midwest for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 1993, and for other purposes. The first
4 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
5 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
6 debate shall be confined to the bill and the amendments
7 made in order by this resolution and shall not exceed nine-
8 ty minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman
9 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
10 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
11 for amendment under the five-minute rule and shall be
12 considered as read. The modification to the bill printed
13 in part 1 of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
14 panying this resolution shall be considered as adopted in
15 the House and in the Committee of the Whole. All points
16 of order against the bill, as modified, are waived. No
17 amendment to the bill, as modified, shall be in order ex-
18 cept the amendment printed in part 2 of the report. The
19 amendment printed in part 2 of the report may be offered
20 only by the named proponent or a designee, shall be con-
21 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
22 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
23 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
24 amendment. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
25 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the

1 bill, as modified, to the House with such amendment as
2 may have been adopted. The previous question shall be
3 considered as ordered on the bill and amendment thereto
4 to final passage without intervening motion except one
5 motion to recommit.
