RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives
respecting waivers of rules.

- 1 *Resolved*, That clause 4 of rule XI of the Rules of
- 2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following new paragraph:

1 “(e) The affirmative percentage of those voting that
2 is required to adopt any rule or order reported by the
3 Committee on Rules providing for the consideration of any
4 bill or resolution that waives any rule of the House shall
5 be the same as the affirmative percentage of those voting
6 that is required by the rules of the House to waive that
7 rule.”.
