RESOLUTION

Providing for the disposition of the Senate amendments to H.R. 2667, a bill making emergency supplemental appropriations for relief from the major, widespread flooding in the Midwest for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 the House shall be considered to have taken from the
3 Speaker's table the bill (H.R. 2667) making emergency
4 supplemental appropriations for relief from the major,
5 widespread flooding in the Midwest for the fiscal year end-
6 ing September 30, 1993, and for other purposes, with Sen-

10 “DISASTER LOANS PROGRAM ACCOUNT

11 “For an additional amount for ‘Disaster loans pro-
12 gram account’ for the cost of direct loans for the Midwest
13 floods and other disasters, \$90,000,000 to remain avail-
14 able until September 30, 1995, of which \$10,000,000, to
15 remain available until expended, may be transferred to
16 and merged with the appropriations for ‘Salaries and Ex-
17 penses’, and of which \$20,000,000 shall be available only
18 to the extent an official budget request for a specific dollar
19 amount, that includes designation of the entire amount of
20 the request as an emergency requirement as defined in
21 the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act
22 of 1985, as amended, is transmitted by the President to
23 the Congress: *Provided further*, That notwithstanding any
24 other provision of law, the \$500,000 limitation on the
25 amounts outstanding and committed to a borrower pro-

1 vided in paragraph 7(c)(6) of the Small Business Act shall
2 be increased to \$1,500,000 for disasters commencing on
3 or after April 1, 1993.”, and

3 “For an additional amount for ‘Programs and activi-
4 ties’ of the”, and

5 On page 3, line 7, of the Senate Engrossed Amend-
6 ments to H.R. 2667, strike “shall be”, and

7 On page 3, line 7, of the Senate Engrossed Amend-
8 ments to H.R. 2667, after \$4,000,000,” insert “for use
9 in carrying out Federal disaster relief programs, activities,
10 and initiatives under subtitles C, E, F, and G of the Na-
11 tional and Community Service Act of 1990 (Public Law
12 101-610), as the Board determines necessary to carry out
13 programs related to the floods in the Midwest, to remain
14 available until September 30, 1994,” and

15 On page 3, line 14 of the Senate Engrossed Amend-
16 ments to H.R. 2667, after “all of the above amounts” in-
17 sert “in this and the preceding three paragraphs”, and

18 On page 3 of the Senate Engrossed Amendments to
19 H.R. 2667, strike lines 18 through 20, and

20 On page 5, after line 7 of the Senate Engrossed
21 Amendments to H.R. 2667, insert the following center
22 heading “Sense of the Senate on Bosnia”, and

23 On page 2 of the House Engrossed Bill, H.R. 2667,
24 strike line 6 and all that follows down through line 2 on
25 page 4, and

1 On page 5 of the House Engrossed Bill, H.R. 2667,
2 strike line 6 and all that follows down through line 22,
3 and

4 On page 7 of the House Engrossed Bill, H.R. 2667,
5 strike line 1 and all that follows through line 14, and

6 On page 8 of the House Engrossed Bill, H.R. 2667,
7 strike line 20 and all that follows through line 11 on page
8 9, and

9 On page 15 of the House Engrossed Bill, H.R. 2667,
10 strike line 11 and all that follows through line 22; and

11 (4) A motion that the House concur in the amend-
12 ment of the Senate numbered 20 with the following

21 *further*, That all of the funds provided under this head
22 in this Act shall be used only to repair, replace, or restore
23 facilities damaged or to continue services interrupted by
24 Midwest floods, high winds, hail and other related weather
25 damages of 1993 and other disasters that are essential

1 to public health or safety as defined by the Secretary”;

3 (6) A motion that the House concur in the amend-
4 ment of the Senate numbered 45 with the following
5 amendment:

6 In lieu of “September 30, 1995” named by said
7 amendment, insert “September 30, 1997”.

8 SEC. 2. No further consideration of the bill shall be
9 in order except pursuant to a subsequent order of the
10 House.

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
