Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1340) to provide funding for the resolution of failed savings associations, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1340) to provide funding for the
6 resolution of failed savings associations, and for other pur-
7 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.

1 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
2 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
3 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
4 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
5 Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs. After
6 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
7 under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the committee
8 amendments now printed in the bill, it shall be in order
9 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
10 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
11 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
12 Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs now printed in the
13 bill, modified by the amendments printed in part 1 of the
14 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
15 lution. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
16 stitute, as modified, shall be considered as read. All points
17 of order against the committee amendment in the nature
18 of a substitute, as modified, are waived. No amendment
19 to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute,
20 as modified, shall be in order except the amendments en
21 bloc printed in part 2 of the report. The amendments en
22 bloc may be offered only by a Member designated in the
23 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
24 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
25 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be

1 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
2 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
3 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against the
4 amendments en bloc are waived. At the conclusion of con-
5 sideration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall
6 rise and report the bill to the House with such amend-
7 ments as may have been adopted. Any Member may de-
8 mand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
9 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
10 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute,
11 as modified. The previous question shall be considered as
12 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-
13 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
14 commit with or without instructions. After passage of
15 H.R. 1340, it shall be in order to take from the Speaker's
16 table the bill S. 714 and to consider the Senate bill in
17 the House. All points of order against the Senate bill and
18 against its consideration are waived. It shall be in order
19 to move to strike all after the enacting clause of the Sen-
20 ate bill and to insert in lieu thereof the provisions of H.R.
21 1340 as passed by the House. All points of order against
22 that motion are waived. If the motion is adopted and the
23 Senate bill, as amended, is passed, then it shall be in order
24 to move that the House insist on its amendments to S.
25 714 and request a conference with the Senate thereon.
