

H. Res. 263

In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

September 29, 1993.

Resolved, That points of order against consideration of the bill (H.R. 3116) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes, for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of the bill, all points of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with “*Provided*” on page 20, line 17, through “operations:” on page 21, line 21; beginning on page 27, line 23, through line 25; beginning on page 108, line 20, through page 109, line 5; and beginning on page 114, line 3, through page 115, line 10. Where points of order are waived against only part of a paragraph, a point of order against matter in the balance of the paragraph may be applied only within the balance of the paragraph and not against the entire paragraph. Points of order under clause 2 of rule XXI against the amendment printed in the report of

the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution are waived.
