RESOLUTION

Waiving certain points of order against the bill (H.R. 3116) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That points of order against consideration
2 of the bill (H.R. 3116) making appropriations for the De-
3 partment of Defense for the fiscal year ending September
4 30, 1994, and for other purposes, for failure to comply
5 with clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. During consider-
6 ation of the bill, all points of order against provisions in

1 the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule
2 XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with “*Pro-*
3 *vided*” on page 20, line 17, through “operations:” on page
4 21, line 21; beginning on page 27, line 23, through line
5 25; beginning on page 108, line 20, through page 109,
6 line 5; and beginning on page 114, line 3, through page
7 115, line 10. Where points of order are waived against
8 only part of a paragraph, a point of order against matter
9 in the balance of the paragraph may be applied only within
10 the balance of the paragraph and not against the entire
11 paragraph. Points of order under clause 2 of rule XXI
12 against the amendment printed in the report of the Com-
13 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution are waived.
