Mr. ZIMMER (for himself, Mr. FRANKS of New Jersey, Mr. CASTLE, and Mr. ROHRBACHER) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

To amend the Rules of the House of Representatives to prohibit bills and joint resolutions from containing more than one subject.

1 *Resolved*, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House
2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
3 following new clause—

4 “9. (a) No bill, joint resolution, or amendment to any
5 bill or joint resolution that contains more than a single
6 subject may be received or considered in the House. A
7 question of order on the number of subjects in any such
8 bill, joint resolution or amendment thereto, may be raised
9 at any time.

1 “(b) The single subject of any bill or joint resolution
2 shall be expressed in the title.

3 “(c) Paragraphs (a) and (b) do not apply to a bill,
4 joint resolution, or amendment thereto that complies, con-
5 solidates, revises, or rearranges the statutory law.”.
