RESOLUTION

Requiring each Member of the House of Representatives
to hold at least 12 town meetings per year in the district
of the Member.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. TOWN MEETING REQUIREMENT.**

3 Each Member of the House of Representatives shall
4 hold at least 12 town meetings each calendar year in the
5 district of the Member. If a Member does not comply with
6 the preceding sentence, in a calendar year, the amount
7 made available to the Member from the Official Mail Al-
8 lowance for the next calendar year shall be reduced by
9 two-thirds.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

2 As used in this resolution, the term “Member of the
3 House of Representatives” means a Representative in, or
4 a Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
