Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1036) to amend the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to provide that such Act does not preempt certain State laws.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1036) to amend the Employee Re-
6 tirement Income Security Act of 1974 to provide that such

1 Act does not preempt certain State laws. The first reading
2 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall
3 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
4 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
5 nority member of the Committee on Education and Labor.
6 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
7 amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not
8 to exceed four hours. It shall be in order to consider as
9 an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the
10 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute recommended by the Committee on Education and
12 Labor now printed in the bill. The committee amendment
13 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.
14 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
15 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
16 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
17 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House
18 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole
19 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature
20 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered
21 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
22 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
23 recommit with or without instructions.
