Mr. BEILENSEN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3450) to implement the North American Free Trade Agreement.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3450) to implement the North
6 American Free Trade Agreement. The first reading of the
7 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
8 the bill and against its consideration are waived. General

1 debate shall proceed without intervening motion, shall be
2 confined to the bill, and shall not exceed eight hours, with
3 two hours for debate in favor of the bill controlled by Rep-
4 resentative Rostenkowski of Illinois or a designee, two
5 hours for debate in opposition to the bill controlled by
6 Representative Gephardt of Missouri or a designee, two
7 hours for debate in favor of the bill controlled by Rep-
8 resentative Michel of Illinois or a designee, and two hours
9 for debate in opposition to the bill controlled by Represent-
10 ative Solomon of New York or a designee. Pursuant to
11 section 151(d) of the Trade Act of 1974, after general
12 debate the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
13 House. Pursuant to section 151(f)(2) of the Trade Act
14 of 1974, the previous question shall be considered as
15 ordered on the bill to final passage without intervening
16 motion.
