Ms. SLAUGHTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 796) to assure freedom of access to clinic entrances.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 796) to assure freedom of access
6 to clinic entrances. The first reading of the bill shall be
7 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration
8 of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined

1 to the bill and the amendments made in order by this reso-
2 lution and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
3 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
4 of the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate
5 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
6 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
7 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
8 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
9 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed
10 in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of
11 a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of order
12 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
13 stitute are waived. No amendment to the committee
14 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order
15 except those printed in the report of the Committee on
16 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each amendment
17 may be offered only in the order printed in the report,
18 may be offered only by a Member designated in the report,
19 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time
20 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
21 the proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject
22 to amendment. All points of order against the amendment
23 numbered 4 in the report are waived. At the conclusion
24 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
25 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such

1 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
2 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
3 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
4 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
5 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
6 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
7 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
8 or without instructions.
