Mr. GORDON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3351) to amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to allow grants for the purpose of developing alternative methods of punishment for young offenders to traditional forms of incarceration and probation.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3351) to amend the Omnibus Crime

1 Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to allow grants for
2 the purpose of developing alternative methods of punish-
3 ment for young offenders to traditional forms of incarcer-
4 ation and probation. The first reading of the bill shall be
5 dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the
6 bill and the amendments made in order by this resolution
7 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
8 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
9 the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate the
10 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
11 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
12 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
13 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
14 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed
15 in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in part 1
16 of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
17 this resolution. The committee amendment in the nature
18 of a substitute, as modified, shall be considered as read.
19 No amendment to the committee amendment in the nature
20 of a substitute, as modified, shall be in order except those
21 printed in part 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules.
22 Each amendment may be offered only in the order printed
23 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
24 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
25 able for the time specified in the report equally divided

1 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
2 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
3 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
4 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
5 the amendment numbered 5 in part 2 of the report are
6 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
7 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
8 to the House with such amendments as may have been
9 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
10 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
11 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature
12 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous
13 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
14 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
15 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
16 structions.
