Expressing the condolences of the House on the death of
Representative Thomas P. “Tip” O’Neill, Jr.

1 *Resolved*, That the House has learned with profound
2 sorrow of the death of the Honorable Thomas P. “Tip”
3 O’Neill, Jr., former Member of the House for 17 terms
4 and Speaker of the House of Representatives for the Nine-
5 ty-fifth, Ninety-sixth, Ninety-seventh, Ninety-eighth and
6 Ninety-ninth Congresses.

7 *Resolved*, That in the death of the Honorable Thomas
8 P. “Tip” O’Neill, Jr. the United States and the Common-
9 wealth of Massachusetts have lost a valued and eminent
10 public servant and citizen.

1 *Resolved*, That the Clerk communicate these resolu-
2 tions to the Senate and transmit a copy thereof to the
3 family of the deceased.

4 *Resolved*, That when the House adjourns today, it ad-
5 journ as a further mark of respect to the memory of the
6 deceased.
