Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6) to extend for six years the authorizations of appropriations for the programs under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, and for certain other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 6) to extend for six years the au-

1 thorizations of appropriations for the programs under the
2 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, and
3 for certain other purposes. The first reading of the bill
4 shall be dispensed with. Points of order against consider-
5 ation of the bill for failure to comply with section 302(f)
6 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are waived. Gen-
7 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
8 ceed two hours equally divided and controlled by the chair-
9 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
10 Education and Labor. After general debate the bill shall
11 be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.
12 It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the
13 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the
14 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by
15 the Committee on Education and Labor now printed in
16 the bill, modified by the amendment printed in section 2
17 of this resolution. The committee amendment in the na-
18 ture of a substitute, as modified, shall be considered by
19 title rather than by section. Each title of the committee
20 amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified,
21 shall be considered as read. Title I of the committee
22 amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified,
23 shall be considered by title of the Elementary and Second-
24 ary Education Act of 1965, as proposed to be amended
25 by title I. Points of order against the committee amend-

1 ment in the nature of a substitute, as modified, for failure
2 to comply with clause 7 of rule XVI or clause 5(a) of rule
3 XXI are waived. No amendment to the committee amend-
4 ment in the nature of a substitute, as modified, shall be
5 in order unless printed in the report of the Committee on
6 Rules accompanying this resolution or in the portion of
7 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
8 clause 6 of rule XXIII prior to Friday, February 25, 1994.
9 Before consideration of any other amendment it shall be
10 in order to consider the amendments printed in the report
11 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
12 Each amendment printed in the report may be offered
13 only in the order printed, may be offered only by a Mem-
14 ber designated in the report, may amend portions of the
15 bill not yet read for amendment, shall be considered as
16 read, shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
17 controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not
18 be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a
19 demand for division of the question in the House or in
20 the Committee of the Whole. Amendments caused to be
21 printed by Representative Kildee of Michigan may be con-
22 sidered en bloc, may amend portions of the bill not yet
23 read for amendment, shall be considered as read, and shall
24 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
25 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. At the

1 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
2 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
3 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member
4 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-
5 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill
6 or to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
7 stitute, as modified. The previous question shall be consid-
8 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
9 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
10 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

11 SEC. 2. The amendment in the nature of a substitute
12 recommended by the Committee on Education and Labor
13 now printed in the bill is modified by striking section 8014
14 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965,
15 as proposed to be amended by title I (page 729, line 15,
16 through page 730, line 21).
