## RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives concerning providing as part of health care reform financial incentives to promote worksite health promotion programs.

1       *Resolved*, it is the sense of the House of Representa-  
2 tives that, regardless of the particular approach taken to  
3 reform the health care system in the United States, there  
4 should be financial incentives for employers to offer work-  
5 site health promotion programs which provide appropriate  
6 screening, counseling, and education for employees at the  
7 worksite in order to promote health, safety, and personal  
8 involvement in preventing illness and injury.
