RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths majority vote to pass any bill, joint resolution, amendment, or conference report raising revenues.

1 *Resolved*, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House
2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
3 following new clause:

4 “8. Any bill, joint resolution, amendment, or con-
5 ference report that raises revenues may be approved in

1 the House only by an affirmative vote of at least three-
2 fifths of the Members voting, a quorum being present.”.
