Mr. BILIRAKIS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 65) to amend title 10, United States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed Forces who have a service-connected disability to receive military retired pay concurrently with veterans' disability compensation.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall resolve itself into the Commit-
3 tee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for the
4 consideration of the bill (H.R. 65) to amend title 10, Unit-
5 ed States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed
6 Forces who have a service-connected disability to receive
7 retired pay concurrently with veterans' disability com-

1 pensionation, and the first reading of the bill shall be dis-
2 pensed with. All points of order against the bill and
3 against its consideration are waived. After general debate
4 which shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by Representative Bilirakis of Florida and the
6 chairman of the Committee on Armed Services, or their
7 designees, the bill shall be considered as having been read
8 for amendment under the five-minute rule. No amendment
9 to the bill shall be in order except one amendment by, and
10 if ordered by, Representative Bilirakis, or a designee, said
11 amendment shall be considered as read, shall not be sub-
12 ject to further amendment but shall be debatable for not
13 a exceed one-hour to be equally divided and controlled by
14 the proponent and an opponent, and all points of order
15 against the amendment are waived.

16 If on any day the Committee of the Whole rises and
17 reports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
18 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
19 after the approval of the Journal, resolve into the Commit-
20 tee of the Whole for further consideration of the bill.

21 At the conclusion of the consideration of the bill for
22 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
23 to the House with such amendment as may have been
24 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
25 dered on the bill and any amendment thereto to final pas-

- 1 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
- 2 commit, with or without instructions.
