Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4092) to control and prevent crime.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4092) to control and prevent crime.  
6 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All  
7 points of order against the bill and against its consider-  
8 ation are waived. General debate shall be confined to the

1 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
2 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
3 the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate the  
4 Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No fur-  
5 ther consideration of the bill shall be in order except pur-  
6 suant to a subsequent order of the House. The require-  
7 ment of clause 4(b) of rule XI for a two-thirds vote to  
8 consider a report from the Committee on Rules on the  
9 same day it is presented to the House is waived with re-  
10 spect to a resolution reported on or before the legislative  
11 day of March 23, 1994, providing for further consider-  
12 ation or disposition of the bill.
