Providing for the concurrence by the House with amendments in amendment of the Senate to H.R. 821.

Mr. MONTGOMERY (for himself, Mr. BONILLA, and Mr. SANGMEISTER) submitted the following resolution; which was considered under the suspension of the rules and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Providing for the concurrence by the House with amendments in amendment of the Senate to H.R. 821.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 the bill (H.R. 821), to amend title 38, United States Code,
3 to extend eligibility for burial in national cemeteries to
4 persons who have 20 years of service creditable for retired
5 pay as members of a reserve component of the Armed
6 Forces, with the Senate amendment thereto, shall be con-
7 sidered to have been taken from the Speaker's table to
8 the end that the Senate amendment thereto be, and the
9 same is hereby, agreed to with amendments as follows:

In lieu of the matter proposed to be inserted by the amendment of the Senate to the text of the bill, insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN RESERVISTS AND DE-**
 2 **PENDENTS FOR BURIAL IN NATIONAL CEME-**
 3 **TERIES.**

4 (a) RESERVISTS.—Section 2402 of title 38, United
 5 States Code, is amended by inserting after paragraph (6)
 6 the following new paragraph (7):

7 “(7) Any person who at the time of death was
 8 entitled to retired pay under chapter 67 of title 10
 9 or would have been entitled to retired pay under
 10 that chapter but for the fact that the person was
 11 under 60 years of age.”.

12 (b) DEPENDENTS.—Paragraph (5) of such section is
 13 amended by inserting “and paragraph (7)” after “para-
 14 graphs (1) through (4)”.

Amend the title so as to read: “An Act to amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for burial in national cemeteries to persons who have 20 years of service creditable for retired pay as members of a reserve component of the Armed Forces and to their dependents.”.
