Mr. BONIOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed.

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3221) to provide for the adjudication of certain claims against the Government of Iraq.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3221) to provide for the adjudica-
6 tion of certain claims against the Government of Iraq. The
7 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General

1 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
2 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
3 and ranking minority member of the Committee on For-
4 eign Affairs. After general debate the bill shall be consid-
5 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall
6 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose
7 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment
8 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-
9 tee on Foreign Affairs now printed in the bill. Each sec-
10 tion of the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute shall be considered as read. Points of order against
12 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
13 for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule XVI are waived.
14 No amendment to the committee amendment in the nature
15 of a substitute shall be in order unless printed in the por-
16 tion of the Congressional Record designated for that pur-
17 pose in clause 6 of rule XXIII before the beginning of con-
18 sideration of the bill. The amendment caused to be printed
19 in the Record by Representative Bereuter of Nebraska (re-
20 lating to certain commercial claims) may amend portions
21 of the bill not yet read for amendment. After disposition
22 of all other amendments to the committee amendment in
23 the nature of a substitute, it shall be in order to consider
24 an amendment caused to be printed in the Record by Rep-
25 resentative Bonior of Michigan (relating to humanitarian

1 assistance) and an amendment caused to be printed in the
2 Record by Representative Solomon of New York (relating
3 to war crimes) in the order stated. Points of order against
4 each of those amendments for failure to comply with
5 clause 7 of rule XVI are waived. After disposition of those
6 amendments, no further amendment to the committee
7 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order.
8 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
9 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
10 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
11 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House
12 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole
13 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature
14 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered
15 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
16 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
17 recommit with or without instructions.
