RESOLUTION

Expressing the profound regret and sorrow of the House of Representatives on the death of Richard Milhous Nixon, former President of the United States of America.

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives has
2 learned with profound regret and sorrow of the death of
3 Richard Milhous Nixon, former President of the United
4 States of America.

5 *Resolved*, That in recognition of the many virtues,
6 public and private, of one who served with distinction as
7 Representative, Senator, Vice President, and President,
8 the Speaker shall appoint committees of the House to join

1 with such Members of the Senate as may be designated,
2 to attend the funeral services of the former President.

3 *Resolved*, That the House tenders its deep sympathy
4 to the members of the family of the former President in
5 their sad bereavement.

6 *Resolved*, That the Sergeant at Arms of the House
7 be authorized and directed to take such steps as may be
8 necessary for carrying out the provisions of these resolu-
9 tions, and that the necessary expenses in connection there-
10 with be paid out of the contingent fund of the House.

11 *Resolved*, That the Clerk communicate these resolu-
12 tions to the Senate and transmit a copy of the same to
13 the family of the former President.

14 *Resolved*, That when the House adjourns today, it ad-
15 journ as a further mark of respect to the memory of the
16 former President.
