## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2442) to reauthorize appropriations under the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, as amended, to revise administrative provisions of the Act to improve the authority of the Secretary of Commerce to administer grant programs, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2442) to reauthorize appropriations  
3 under the Public Works and Economic Development Act  
4 of 1965, as amended, to revise administrative provisions  
5 of the Act to improve the authority of the Secretary of  
6 Commerce to administer grant programs, and for other  
7 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed  
8 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
9 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill  
10 and the amendments made in order by this resolution and  
11 shall not exceed ninety minutes, with sixty minutes equally  
12 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
13 nority member of the Committee on Public Works and  
14 Transportation and thirty minutes equally divided and  
15 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member  
16 of the Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs.  
17 After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
18 amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the com-  
19 mittee amendments now printed in the bill, it shall be in  
20 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
21 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in  
22 the nature of a substitute printed in part 1 of the report  
23 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.  
24 The amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be con-  
25 sidered as read. Before consideration of any other amend-

1 ment it shall be in order to consider the amendment print-  
2 ed in part 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules, if  
3 offered by a Member designated in the report. All points  
4 of order against the amendments printed in the report are  
5 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
6 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
7 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
8 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the  
9 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of  
10 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature  
11 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous  
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
13 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
14 motion except one motion to recommit with or without  
15 instructions.
