Ms. SLAUGHTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2108) to make improvements in the Black Lung Benefits Act.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2108) to make improvements in  
6 the Black Lung Benefits Act. The first reading of the bill  
7 shall be dispensed with. Points of order against consider-  
8 ation of the bill for failure to comply with section

1 401(b)(1) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are  
2 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and  
3 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled  
4 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the  
5 Committee on Education and Labor. After general debate  
6 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
7 minute rule for a period not to exceed three hours (exclud-  
8 ing time consumed by recorded votes and proceedings inci-  
9 dental thereto). It shall be in order to consider as an origi-  
10 nal bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-  
11 minute rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute  
12 consisting of the text of H.R. 4415. The amendment in  
13 the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. At  
14 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment  
15 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House  
16 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any  
17 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any  
18 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the  
19 bill or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute  
20 made in order as original text. The previous question shall  
21 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments  
22 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except  
23 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
