RESOLUTION

Directing the Committee on House Administration to make public all transcripts of proceedings and documents related to the investigation of the House Administration Committee Task Force to Investigate the Operation and Management of the House Post Office.

Whereas the Committee on House Administration ordered reported on July 22, 1992, the findings of the Committee Task Force to Investigate the Operation and Management of the House Post Office;

Whereas the House has voted three times to not make public all Task Force transcripts and documents regarding the internal Committee on House Administration investigation in light of the then-ongoing investigative activities by the Department of Justice;

Whereas the Department of Justice has now completed the investigatory phase of its House Post Office investigation; and

Whereas matters have been raised which impugn the integrity of the proceedings of the House of Representatives: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Committee on House Administra-
2 tion is directed to make public all transcripts of proceed-
3 ings and documents related to the investigation of the
4 House Administration Committee Task Force to Inves-
5 tigate the Operation and Management of the House Post
6 Office leading to its final report.
