Mr. MOAKLEY from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4385) to amend title 23, United States Code, to designate the National Highway System, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4385) to amend title 23, United
6 States Code, to designate the National Highway System,
7 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall

1 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the
2 bill and the amendments made in order by this resolution
3 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
4 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
5 the Committee on Public Works and Transportation. After
6 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
7 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
8 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
9 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
10 stitute recommended by the Committee on Public Works
11 and Transportation now printed in the bill. The committee
12 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
13 ered as read. All points of order against the committee
14 amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived. Ex-
15 cept as otherwise provided in this resolution, no amend-
16 ment to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
17 stitute shall be in order except those printed in the report
18 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
19 Each amendment printed in the report may be offered
20 only in the order printed, may be offered only by a Mem-
21 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
22 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
23 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
24 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment except as
25 specified in the report, and shall not be subject to a de-

1 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
2 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
3 amendments printed in the report are waived. It shall be
4 in order at any time for the chairman of the Committee
5 on Public Works and Transportation or a designee to offer
6 amendments en bloc consisting of amendments printed in
7 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
8 resolution or germane modifications of any such amend-
9 ment. Amendments en bloc offered pursuant to this sec-
10 tion shall be considered as read (except that modifications
11 shall be reported), shall be debatable for ten minutes
12 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
13 ing minority member of the Committee on Public Works
14 and Transportation, shall not be subject to amendment,
15 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the
16 question in the House or in the Committee of Whole. For
17 the purpose of inclusion in such amendments en bloc, an
18 amendment printed in the form of a motion to strike may
19 be modified to the form of a germane perfecting amend-
20 ment to the text originally proposed to be stricken. All
21 points of order against such amendments en bloc are
22 waived. The original proponent of an amendment included
23 in such amendments en bloc may insert a statement in
24 the Congressional Record immediately before the disposi-
25 tion of the amendments en bloc. At the conclusion of con-

1 sideration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall
2 rise and report the bill to the House with such amend-
3 ments as may have been adopted. Any Member may de-
4 mand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
5 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
6 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
7 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
8 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
9 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
10 or without instructions.
