Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4454) making appropriations for the legislative branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4454) making appropriations for
6 the legislative branch for the fiscal year ending September
7 30, 1995, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

1 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
2 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
3 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
4 ity member of the Committee on Appropriations. After
5 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
6 under the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read.
7 Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure
8 to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. No
9 amendment shall be in order except those printed in the
10 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
11 lution. Each amendment may be offered only in the order
12 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
13 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
14 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
15 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
16 shall not be subject to amendment except as specified in
17 the report, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
18 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee
19 of the Whole. All points of order against amendments
20 printed in the report are waived. The chairman of the
21 Committee of the Whole may postpone until a time during
22 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-
23 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment made in
24 order by this resolution. The chairman of the Committee
25 of the Whole may reduce to not less than five minutes

1 the time for voting by electronic device on any postponed
2 question that immediately follows another vote by elec-
3 tronic device without intervening business, provided that
4 the time for voting by electronic device on the first in any
5 series of questions shall be not less than fifteen minutes.
6 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
7 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
8 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
9 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
10 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
11 intervening motion except one motion to recommit, or to
12 recommit with instructions if offered by Representative
13 Young of Florida or a designee.
