Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4539) making appropriations for the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Service, the Executive Office of the President, and certain Independent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4539) making appropriations for

1 the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Serv-
2 ice, the Executive Office of the President, and certain
3 Independent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending Septem-
4 ber 30, 1995, and for other purposes. The first reading
5 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
6 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
7 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
8 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
9 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-
10 tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
11 amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
12 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
13 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: begin-
14 ning with “: *Provided*” on page 4, line 6, through “Treas-
15 ury” on line 9; and page 87, line 3, through page 88, line
16 2. Where points of order are waived against only part of
17 a paragraph, a point of order against matter in the bal-
18 ance of the paragraph may be applied only within the bal-
19 ance of the paragraph and not against the entire para-
20 graph. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
21 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
22 to the House with such amendments as may have been
23 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
24 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage

1 without intervening motion except one motion to recom-
2 mit.

3 SEC. 2. At any time after the adoption of this resolu-
4 tion the Committee on Appropriations may file a supple-
5 mental report on H.R. 4539 as part 2 of House Report
6 103-534.
