Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That points of order against consideration
2 of the bill (H.R. 4603) making appropriations for the De-
3 partments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary,
4 and related agencies programs for the fiscal year ending
5 September 30, 1995, and making supplemental appropria-
6 tions for these departments and agencies for the fiscal
7 year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes,
8 for failure to comply with clause 2(l)(6) of rule XI or

1 clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of
2 the bill, all points of order against provisions in the bill
3 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived
4 except as follows: beginning with “notwithstanding” on
5 page 3, line 18, through “Act,” on line 19; beginning with
6 “That” on page 36, line 16, through “*Provided further,*”
7 on page 37, line 6; and beginning with “: *Provided*” on
8 page 48, line 25, through “Treasury” on page 49, line
9 4. Where points of order are waived against only part of
10 a paragraph, any point of order against matter in the bal-
11 ance of the paragraph may be applied only within the bal-
12 ance of the paragraph and not against the entire para-
13 graph. The amendment printed in the report of the Com-
14 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall have
15 precedence over a motion that the Committee of the Whole
16 rise and report the bill to the House with such amend-
17 ments as may have been adopted, if the amendment is of-
18 fered by a Member designated in the report.
