Mr. GORDON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1188) to provide for disclosures for insurance in interstate commerce.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1188) to provide for disclosures for  
6 insurance in interstate commerce. The first reading of the  
7 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-  
8 fined to the bill and the amendments made in order by

1 this resolution and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
2 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-  
3 ity member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce.  
4 After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
5 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order  
6 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-  
7 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-  
8 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on  
9 Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill. The com-  
10 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be  
11 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of  
12 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-  
13 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may  
14 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate  
15 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-  
16 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-  
17 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question  
18 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments  
19 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except  
20 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
