Ms. SLAUGHTER from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3838) to amend and extend certain laws relating to housing and community development, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3838) to amend and extend certain  
6 laws relating to housing and community development, and  
7 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration  
2 of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined  
3 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
4 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
5 member of the Committee on Banking, Finance and  
6 Urban Affairs. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
7 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall  
8 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
9 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
10 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-  
11 tee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs now printed  
12 in the bill. The amendment in the nature of a substitute  
13 shall be considered by title rather than by section. Each  
14 title shall be considered as read. Points of order against  
15 the amendment in the nature of a substitute for failure  
16 to comply with clause 7 of rule XVI or clause 5(a) of rule  
17 XXI are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the  
18 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report  
19 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have  
20 been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote  
21 in the House on any amendment adopted in the Commit-  
22 tee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-  
23 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question  
24 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments

- 1 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
- 2 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
