Mr. DERRICK from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4604) to establish direct spending targets, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4604) to establish direct spending  
6 targets, and for other purposes. The first reading of the  
7 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-  
8 fined to the bill and the amendments made in order by

1 this resolution and shall not exceed one hour, with thirty  
2 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
3 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Rules  
4 and thirty minutes equally divided and controlled by the  
5 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
6 on Government Operations. After general debate the bill  
7 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute  
8 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill  
9 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule  
10 an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of  
11 the text of the bill modified by the amendment printed  
12 in part 1 of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-  
13 panying this resolution. That amendment in the nature  
14 of a substitute shall be considered as read. No other  
15 amendment shall be in order except those printed in part  
16 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules. Each amend-  
17 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-  
18 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the  
19 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for  
20 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-  
21 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
22 subject to amendment except as specified in the report,  
23 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the  
24 question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.  
25 All points of order against the amendments printed in part

1 2 of the report are waived. If more than one of the amend-  
2 ments printed in part 2 of the report is adopted, only the  
3 last to be adopted shall be considered as finally adopted  
4 and reported to the House. At the conclusion of consider-  
5 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
6 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
7 as may have been finally adopted. Any Member may de-  
8 mand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
9 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
10 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order  
11 as original text. The previous question shall be considered  
12 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
13 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
14 recommit with or without instructions.
