1 *Resolved*, That the bill of the Senate (S. 729) to
2 amend the Toxic Substances Control Act to reduce the lev-
3 els of lead in the environment, and for other purposes,
4 in the opinion of this House, contravenes the first clause
5 of the seventh section of the first article of the Constitu-
6 tion of the United States and is an infringement of the
7 privileges of this House and that such bill be respectfully
8 returned to the Senate with a message communicating this
9 resolution.
