Mr. MOAKLEY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution, which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2448) to improve the accuracy of radon testing products and services, to increase testing for radon, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2448) to improve the accuracy of
6 radon testing products and services, to increase testing for

1 radon, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
2 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
3 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
5 ity member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce.
6 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
7 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
8 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
9 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
10 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
11 Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill. Each sec-
12 tion of the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
13 stitute shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of
14 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
15 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
16 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
17 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
18 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
19 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
20 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
21 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
22 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
23 or without instructions.
