Mr. HALL of Ohio, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 1066) to restore Federal services to the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (S. 1066) to restore Federal services to
6 the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians. The first read-
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall

1 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
2 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
3 nority member of the Committee on Natural Resources.
4 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
5 amendment under the five-minute rule. Each section of
6 the bill shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of
7 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
8 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
9 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
12 motion except one motion to recommit.
