Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4822) to make certain laws applicable to the legislative branch of the Federal Government.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4822) to make certain laws applica-  
6 ble to the legislative branch of the Federal Government.  
7 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Gen-

1 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and the amend-  
2 ments made in order by this resolution and shall not ex-  
3 ceed one hour, with thirty minutes equally divided and  
4 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member  
5 of the Committee on Rules and thirty minutes equally di-  
6 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-  
7 ity member of the Committee on House Administration.  
8 After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
9 amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the com-  
10 mittee amendments now printed in the bill, it shall be in  
11 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
12 amendment under the five-minute rule an amendment in  
13 the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R.  
14 4892 modified by the amendments printed in part 1 of  
15 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this  
16 resolution. That amendment in the nature of a substitute  
17 shall be considered as read. No amendment to the amend-  
18 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except  
19 those printed in part 2 of the report of the Committee  
20 on Rules. Each amendment may be offered only in the  
21 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-  
22 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,  
23 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report  
24 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
25 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment except as

1 specified in the report, and shall not be subject to a de-  
2 mand for division of the question in the House or in the  
3 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against  
4 amendments printed in part 2 of the report are waived.  
5 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-  
6 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the  
7 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.  
8 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House  
9 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole  
10 to the bill or to the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
11 stitute made in order as original text. The previous ques-  
12 tion shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-  
13 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
14 except one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
15 tions.
