

H. Res. 516

In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

August 18, 1994.

Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3433) to provide for the management of portions of the Presidio under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and the amendments made in order by this resolution and shall not exceed seventy-five minutes, with forty-five minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural Resources and thirty minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and Means. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not to exceed three hours (excluding time consumed by recorded votes

and proceedings incidental thereto). It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill, modified by the amendments recommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the bill and by the amendments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified, shall be considered as read. All points of order against the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified, are waived. No amendment directly or indirectly changing section 3(h)(9), section 3(h)(12), section 3(h)(13), or section 3(j) of the amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified, shall be in order. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening

motion except one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
