Ms. SLAUGHTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3433) to provide for the management of portions of the Presidio under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3433) to provide for the manage-  
6 ment of portions of the Presidio under the jurisdiction of  
7 the Secretary of the Interior. The first reading of the bill

1 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-  
2 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-  
3 fined to the bill and the amendments made in order by  
4 this resolution and shall not exceed seventy-five minutes,  
5 with forty-five minutes equally divided and controlled by  
6 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-  
7 mittee on Natural Resources and thirty minutes equally  
8 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
9 nority member of the Committee on Ways and Means.  
10 After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
11 amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not  
12 to exceed three hours (excluding time consumed by re-  
13 corded votes and proceedings incidental thereto). It shall  
14 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
15 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
16 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-  
17 tee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill, modified  
18 by the amendments recommended by the Committee on  
19 Ways and Means now printed in the bill and by the  
20 amendments printed in the report of the Committee on  
21 Rules accompanying this resolution. The committee  
22 amendment in the nature of a substitute, as modified,  
23 shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
24 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute,  
25 as modified, are waived. No amendment directly or indi-

1 rectly changing section 3(h)(9), section 3(h)(12), section  
2 3(h)(13), or section 3(j) of the amendment in the nature  
3 of a substitute, as modified, shall be in order. At the con-  
4 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
5 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
6 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member  
7 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-  
8 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill  
9 or to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
10 stitute, as modified. The previous question shall be consid-  
11 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to  
12 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-  
13 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
