Mr. MOAKLEY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4008) to authorize appropriations for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for fiscal years 1994 and 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4008) to authorize appropriations
6 for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration

1 for fiscal years 1994 and 1995, and for other purposes.
2 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All
3 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
4 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
5 exceed one hour, with thirty minutes equally divided and
6 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
7 of the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries and
8 thirty minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair-
9 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
10 Science, Space, and Technology. After general debate the
11 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
12 minute rule. In lieu of the committee amendments now
13 printed in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an
14 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-
15 minute rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute
16 consisting of the text of H.R. 5046. That amendment in
17 the nature of a substitute shall be considered by title rath-
18 er than by section. Each title shall be considered as read.
19 All points of order against that amendment in the nature
20 of a substitute are waived. At the conclusion of consider-
21 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
22 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
23 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
24 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
25 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-

1 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-
2 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-
3 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
4 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
5 with or without instructions.
