Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed.

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3171) to authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to reorganize the Department of Agriculture, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3171) to authorize the Secretary
6 of Agriculture to reorganize the Department of Agri-
7 culture, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

1 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
2 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
3 be confined to the bill and the amendments made in order
4 by this resolution and shall not exceed one hour equally
5 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
6 nority member of the Committee on Agriculture. After
7 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
8 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
9 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
10 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute recommended by the Committee on Agriculture
12 now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the
13 nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. All
14 points of order against the committee amendment in the
15 nature of a substitute are waived. At the conclusion of
16 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
17 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
18 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
19 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
20 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
21 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
22 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
23 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
24 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
25 or without instructions.
