Mr. BONIOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4779) to amend the Solid Waste Disposal Act to authorize local governments and Governors to restrict receipt of out-of-State municipal solid waste, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4779) to amend the Solid Waste

1 Disposal Act to authorize local governments and Gov-
2 ernors to restrict receipt of out-of-State municipal solid
3 waste, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
4 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
5 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
6 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
7 ity member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce.
8 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
9 amendment under the five-minute rule for a period not
10 to exceed four hours (excluding time consumed by re-
11 corded votes and proceedings incidental thereto). It shall
12 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose
13 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment
14 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-
15 tee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill. Each
16 section of the committee amendment in the nature of a
17 substitute shall be considered as read. Any amendment of-
18 fered by the chairman of the Committee on Energy and
19 Commerce or his designee may amend portions of the bill
20 not yet read for amendment. At the conclusion of consider-
21 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
22 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
23 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
24 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
25 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the commit-

1 tee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
3 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
5 structions.
