IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

JANUARY 27, 1993

Mr. SOLOMON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Foreign Affairs

RESOLUTION

Relating to the prosecution of Saddam Hussein and
responsible members of the Iraqi Government for war crimes.

1 The House finds that—

2 (1) as ordered by Saddam Hussein, Iraq en-
3 gaged in unprovoked aggression in its conquest and
4 occupation of Kuwait;

5 (2) the Iraqi occupation force has treated Ku-
6 waiti citizens barbarously;

7 (3) Saddam Hussein used American and Euro-
8 pean civilians as “human shields” in an attempt to
9 protect strategic facilities throughout Iraq and has

1 now directed that captured American and Allied
2 prisoners of war be used for the same purpose;

3 (4) Saddam Hussein ordered his military to
4 launch missile attacks against innocent civilians in
5 Israel and Saudi Arabia; and

6 (5) Former President Bush and President Clin-
7 ton have rightly warned Saddam Hussein and Iraqi
8 Government officials that they would be held respon-
9 sible for any abuses they have caused: Now, there-
10 fore, be it

11 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-
12 resentatives to urge the President to request the United
13 Nations to establish a tribunal to charge Saddam Hussein
14 and other responsible Iraqi Government officials for war
15 crimes, acts of aggression, and crimes against humanity
16 they have committed.
