Mr. POMEROY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Requiring Members of the House of Representatives to pay, from the Official Expenses Allowance, the actual cost of extraneous matter printed in that portion of the Congressional Record entitled “Extensions of Remarks”.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN EXTEN-**
3 **SIONS OF REMARKS.**

4 In each case of extraneous matter printed in that por-
5 tion of the Congressional Record entitled “Extensions of
6 Remarks”, the actual cost involved shall be paid out of
7 the Official Expenses Allowance of the Member who sub-
8 mits the matter. The amounts so paid shall be credited

1 to the applicable appropriation relating to publication of
2 the Congressional Record.

3 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE SPEAKER.**

4 The Speaker shall have authority to specify such
5 standards and to make such determinations as may be
6 necessary to assure compliance with this resolution.

7 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

8 As used in this resolution—

9 (1) the term “actual cost” means the actual
10 cost, as determined by the Public Printer;

11 (2) the term “extraneous matter” means matter
12 not related to the legislative business of the day; and

13 (3) the term “Member of the House of Rep-
14 resentatives” means a Representative in, or a Dele-
15 gate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
