RESOLUTION

Returning to the Senate S. 1216, to resolve the 107th meridian boundary dispute between the Crow Indian Tribe and the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That the bill of the Senate (S. 1216) enti-
2 tled the “Crow Boundary Settlement Act of 1994”, in the
3 opinion of this House, contravenes the first clause of the
4 seventh section of the first article of the Constitution of
5 the United States and is an infringement of the privileges
6 of this House and that such bill be respectfully returned
7 to the Senate with a message communicating this resolu-
8 tion.
