Mr. FROST, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2) to establish national voter reg-
6 istration procedures for Federal elections, and for other
7 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed
8 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill
9 for failure to comply with clause 2(l)(6) of rule XI are
10 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and

1 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
2 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
3 Committee on House Administration. After general debate
4 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
5 minute rule. The amendments recommended by the Com-
6 mittee on House Administration now printed in the bill
7 and the amendment printed in part 1 of the report of the
8 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be
9 considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee
10 of the Whole. The bill as so amended shall be considered
11 as read. No further amendment shall be in order except
12 an amendment printed in part 2 of the report of the Com-
13 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Such
14 amendment may be offered only by the named proponent
15 or a designee, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
16 able for one hour equally divided and controlled by the
17 proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
18 amendment. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
19 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
20 bill to the House with such amendment as may have been
21 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as
22 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-
23 sage without intervening motion except one motion to
24 recommit.
