Mr. GLICKMAN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts from the contingent fund of the House for expenses of investigations and studies by the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence in the first session of the One Hundred Third Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) for expenses of investigations and
2 studies by the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
3 ligence (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the
4 “Committee”), including expenses for provision of assist-
5 ance for members of professional staff in obtaining spe-
6 cialized training under section 202(j) of the Legislative
7 Reorganization Act of 1946, there shall be paid out of the
8 contingent fund of the House not more than \$110,000.

1 (b) Not more than \$5,000 of the amount specified
2 in subsection (a) may be used for specialized training re-
3 ferred to in such subsection.

4 SEC. 2. Payments under this resolution shall be made
5 on vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
6 Chairman of the Committee, and approved by the Commit-
7 tee on House Administration.

8 SEC. 3. Amounts shall be available under this resolu-
9 tion for investigations and studies carried out during the
10 period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and ending
11 immediately before noon on January 3, 1994.

12 SEC. 4. Amounts made available under this resolution
13 shall be expended in accordance with regulations pre-
14 scribed by the Committee on House Administration.
